

All the activities carried out allowed the **7** beneficiary communities to be affected, contributing to the awareness of these issues, reducing the incidence of acute diarrheal disease and respiratory infection in children through the prevention of risk factors. Child Mortality

As a strategy for the identification of incidents and prevalent cases of acute respiratory infection and diarrheal disease, **180** home visits were made in **70** homes, a greater than expected number (**60**); in which education was provided on signs and symptoms of respiratory infection, information was provided on how to prevent illness and home care. Through these visits, 128 incident cases of the disease could be identified, exceeding 28% of those expected before project execution; that were followed up and given pharmaceutical treatment in a timely manner.



Prenatal Care:

A total of **120** pregnant women were assisted in prenatal control, who were accompanied in their monthly controls, in total **75** home visits were made to these pregnant women and infants who were explained about childbirth care, and postpartum, received education about their hormonal changes, food and recommendations in case of presenting signs of alarm, which will put their lives or babies' lives at risk. Only 2 cases were identified in which it was required to refer a higher level of care to pregnant patients to receive timely medical attention.



Growth and Development Control:


196 growth and development controls were carried out for children under 10 years old, **30.7%** more than planned, which allowed following normal conditions of height and weight for age. These children and their parents were given education about healthy eating and recommendations to identify signs of low weight alarm during their follow-up checks. A total of **52** cases of malnutrition were identified, **4%** more, these cases entered our program of children's canteens, in order to support parents in the recovery of children's weight and were referred for pediatric evaluation to receive the indicated treatment .



Among the activities carried out in the project we also found that a total of **643** patients were treated, which were assessed by the doctor or dentistry receiving a diagnosis and pharmaceutical



treatment for free, some of these patients had to be referred to another level of care to your treatment and rehabilitation, avoiding delays in the attention and health complications.



GENERATED IMPACT

The health of **128** children who presented acute respiratory distress were recovered, they received timely treatment. And **100%** of parents received education and know how to prevent respiratory infection and diarrhea. The morbidity rate due to respiratory infection in the same household is reduced from 20% to 9.43%. It was possible to reduce the incidence of diarrhea from 37.7% by 9.3% according to the survey. With the campaigns carried out and the hygiene education provided, it was achieved that of 5.6% of people who boiled water for consumption, went to **37.8%**, increasing the percentage of people who boil the water, improving their health and acquiring habits of healthy hygiene.

Of the **70** households that were educated, that is 16% more than expected, 14.8% have changed their knowledge of hygiene habits, according to baseline monitoring

52 children improving their nutritional health and regaining their weight benefiting from the Feeding Program.

120 pregnant women who attended the prenatal check carried out their pregnancy in a healthy way.

643 people in total received medical assistance, which led to improvements in their health, allowing them to return to their jobs and to contribute to the increase in household income positively impacting their relatives, approximately **1,040** people. An accompaniment was made to women and their children on a physical, emotional and spiritual level allowing a positive transformation and impact on their lives. Providing greater community development.




80% of women and parents benefited from the project know what the health services available to their children are and know how to access them.

80% of the pregnant women identified continued receiving their prenatal controls periodically and ended their pregnancy without complications. Children under 10 years of age who initiated the growth and development controls periodically attended these in 50%.

The project will continue to be replicated because the trained leaders are young people from the educational institution of the community, and they will continue to provide periodic educational talks to more children, women and parents in the different communities.



Baseline Tracking




The percentage of compliance with the project indicators shows a 100% scope of the activities, some of which were executed in a higher percentage than expected, due to the management carried out.



Financial Report



The funds were 100% executed, as the following graphs show.

93.8% were expenses generated to carry out the home visits to carry out the prenatal controls, growth and development and education in health, concentrating the greater expense in the heading, safeguarding the maternal health and the growth and development of children under 10 years.

Women



72.2% of the expenses were allocated to the monitoring and evaluation of the project, being part of the cross-cutting operating costs item.
